Pupil Challenge:

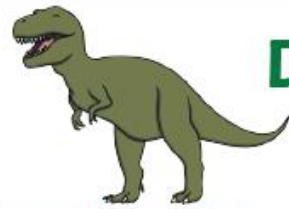

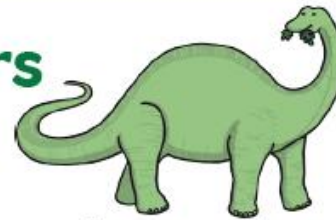
