Katherine Johnson studied maths and worked out the trateory of planes and rockets which eventually helped the Apollo11 space mission go to the moon.

She was very intelligent that she was able to attend secondary school a year early at the age of 10! Myla


When working with NASA in the 1960s, women were given the jobs that were thought of as being 'boring' - calculating the maths necessary for space travel. Ador.

She had a love of maths which her teacher Miss Turner realised and supported her to improve and complete more challenging work. Nawal

Katherine Johnson is similar to Malala both faced difficulties in their education and careers because they were women who were treated differently to men. Muna

At first, Katherine's jobs prospects were limited to teaching or nursing, the NACA (which became NASA) started employing women. Taylan.

She loved school, but could go to the high school near her because she was black. So her family had to move.



Katherine Johnson worked on the Apollo missions like the one Neil armstrong went on when he went to the moon.



When Apollo 13 was in trouble Katherine Johnson made some calculations so that the astronauts could use the moon's gravity and shoot the spaceship like a slingshot back to Earth.
