



"I printed a pattern on my sundial, circle, square, circle, square" Dingani






Lilly - A long time ago they told the time with the stick and the sun and the shadow

Atlas - First we got a big or small cup and got a big cup or a small cup and used that to draw around it and cut it out.






















His most famous art pieces were called 'The persistence of memory' (1931) and 'Sleep' (1937) - Zavi


There was a quiz using baby pictures and we had to guess which teacher they were. -Ayan

Warren taught us how to make the movies. I was in a group with Noemi and Abdul. -Erika


For STEAM week we learnt how to draw cogs and then made a piece of art using the cogs. - Meryem

We looked at different Osidge uniforms from the past and guessed the year (Mario)






Using clay, we have made a flattened clock. We made it look like it had melted, like this painting here. This was because the clocks have been missing so we need to complete certain missions! (Lauren)






We had to carefully mold the clay, so that there were no cracks. We thought about time melting and what life would be like without time! Everything would stop moving! (Taliyah)




6L looked at and sketched the internal mechanisms of clock.
