


In Year 3, we have been learning all about Garrett Morgan and his amazing achievements! We created an fact file as well as our very own traffic lights.

4S learned about the life and struggles of **Nelson Mandela**. They learned about the values he stood for - equality, justice and forgiveness



Her local school in didn't allow any black children to join as America was segregated by race.


Her dream job was to be a research mathematician as she always loved maths.

She earned a reputation for being very accurate and a leader.

She always knew how important her job was to help plan flight paths for spacecrafts.

Her calculations helped bring home the astronauts on Apollo 13 after their spacecraft was damaged in space.

We have been learning about an amazing mathematician called Katherine Johnson.


We read a book about her life called 'Counting on Katherine'.

She helped solve math calculations for NASA which ensured the success of space missions. She was called the human computer by the astronauts. Waleed




Who is... Maggie Aderin-Pocock?





