

"When you say please and thank you you show respect".


"Bullying is bad. When you kick, hit or punch someone is bullying"

5. If someone is sad, give a cuddle.






Our kindness battery was fully charged by the end of the week with little acts of kindness!



We read the book and ALL agreed that we should always respect our differences.




We discussed how little acts of kindness can make a big difference in someone's day.




We agreed that following our 4T rules will make our friendships stronger and our class even better!

"Celebrate our differences! It would be boring if everyone was the same."




