This week, all children took part in a range of activities to mark Anti-Bullying Week. Their learning helped remind them how to recognise bullying, respond safely, and seek support from a trusted adult. They explored why care matters, how to speak up when something is upsetting them, and how respectful, open dialogue helps us build a future generation of tolerant, compassionate and generous individuals.

Odd Socks Monday reminded everyone that our differences make us unique and that this should be celebrated.

Children in Years 2, 5 and 6 also took part in the NSPCC's **Speak out. Stay safe.** workshops, focusing on the theme 'Power of Good' to empower children to combat bullying and promote kindness. Children learnt about their right to feel safe, who they can talk to if they are worried, and the different types of hurt — emphasising that no problem is ever too big or too small to share.

Today's 'Wear Something Spotty' fundraiser for Children in Need brought a colourful end to the week. A big thank you to Ms Suleyman for organising these wonderful PSHE activities in school.

Our Osidge Ambassadors led thoughtful assemblies on Tuesday morning about Remembrance Day, explaining the significance of the red poppy. At the end of playtime, children stood in a quiet circle with their classmates and together as a school we held a minute's silence outside.


Well done to the Osidge girls for coming home with the Silver.

Free Child Car Seat Checks

Friday 21st November, 10am - 3pm

Asda Colindale car park off Capitol Way, Edgware Rd, London NW9 0AS

Barnet Council is offering free child car seat safety checks to ensure children are travelling safely. A trained expert from Good Egg Safety will be available to inspect seats, fix errors and provide advice, no booking required.

A check can be made on your child car seat even if your child isn't with you — but if they are, we can also check they are seated correctly and safely.

Last year, 92% of seats checked in Barnet had errors, many serious enough to endanger children in the event of a collision. Unfortunately, errors on seats are very easily made, but the great news is that they tend to be easy to fix.

Don't miss this opportunity to get peace of mind and help make Barnet's roads safer for everyone.
