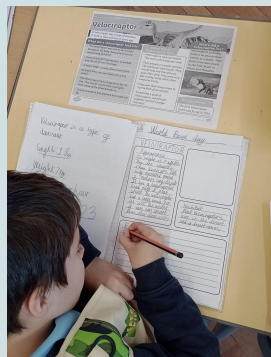
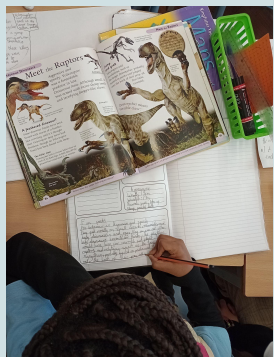


Diet
